Organisational context

The Shire of Gnowangerup is situated in the Great Southern region of Western Australia, approximately three and half hours south of Perth. It has a land area of 5,000 square kilometres and approximately 1,000 kilometres of roads. There are three towns in the Shire: Borden, Ongerup and Gnowangerup.

The Shire contains around 100,000 hectares of farmland and supports a highly efficient livestock and cropping industry of wheat, lupins barley, canola, clover seeds, peas, oats and fava beans. The area is renowned Australia-wide for its merino sheep.
